### **Jharkhand UrjaSancharan Nigam Limited (JUSNL)**

**Objections / Comments invited from various stakeholders on the petitions filed by Jharkhand UrjaSancharan Nigam Limited (JUSNL) for True-up of FY 2020-21 & FY 2021-22, APR for FY 2022-23, and ARR & Tariff for FY 2023-24.**

Jharkhand UrjaSancharan Nigam Ltd. (JUSNL or the Petitioner) has been incorporated under Indian Companies Act, 1956 pursuant to the decision of Government of Jharkhand to reorganize erstwhile JSEB. Reorganization of the JSEB has been done by Government of Jharkhand pursuant to 'Part XIII-Reorganization of Board' read with Section 131 of The Electricity Act 2003. The Petitioner is a Company constituted under the provisions of Government of Jharkhand, General Resolution as notified by transfer scheme vide notification no. 8, dated 6th January 2014, and is duly registered with the Registrar of Companies, Ranchi.

JUSNL was incorporated on October 23, 2013 with the Registrar of Companies, Jharkhand, Ranchi and obtained Certificate of Commencement of Business on November 28, 2013. It is a Transmission Licensee under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 (EA, 2003) having license to establish or operate transmission lines in the State of Jharkhand. It is functioning in accordance with the provisions envisaged in the Electricity Act, 2003 and is engaged in the business of Transmission of electricity to its consumers situated over the entire State of Jharkhand.

In accordance with the JSERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations, 2015, and JSERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations, 2020, JUSNL has filed a Petition for True-up of FY 2020-21 & FY 2021-22, APR for FY 2022-23, and ARR & Tariff for FY 2023-24.

The Commission has directed JUSNL to publish a public notice inviting objections/comments from various stakeholders on the above Petitions.
